He has been visiting the bank at least twice a week to withdraw money for the construction. Due to COVID-19 restrictions, only a few people are allowed to enter the bank at a time. During one of the visits, the security guard had an altercation with one customer and it was really bad. Joshua intervened and the issue was solved.

During his next visit, he met the same guy and had a conversation with him. They exchanged contacts and Joshua followed up with him and the conversation developed into sharing the salvation of Jesus Christ with him. Five weeks after their first encounter, the guy called Joshua and asked him to baptize him that morning.

Joshua was on his way to the construction site to check on the workers and also meet with the contractor for the next step with the wall. He was 30 minutes away from the site and an hour and half to where the guy was. He decided to turn back and met the guy near the ocean and baptized him. Because Joshua took advantage of that opportunity to intervene, this guy's life was transformed through the gospel of Jesus Christ.

He was very excited and pleased about Joshua's response to baptize him and said, "I can feel the power of God in me and I am going to take my wife and two children to church."
